The Parish Council had said goodbye to retiring Handyman Kevin Gill and had welcomed new Handyman Steve Bramwell and Councillor Steve Jones.

Cllr M Buttery also reported that the Parish Council had given a total of £2,000 in donations to Little Nippers Pre-School, Rainworth Village Hall, the 2013 Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal, Rainworth Miners Welfare Bonfire & Fireworks Display and Rainworth Skate Park association.
