POLICE

Items discussed were:

PLAYING FIELDS & OPEN SPACES

Items discussed were:

- Posters to be made reminding dog walkers that bagged dog waste can be deposited in normal litter bins

TRANSPORT, HIGHWAYS, FOOTWAYS & LIGHTING

- Temporary road closure notice received – North Ave from its junction with Cross Drive for a distance of 80 metres in a westerly direction 08:00 hrs 30-8-2016 to 18:00 hrs 2-9-2016 for new gas connection works.
- Sink holes around grates at the junction of Southwell Rd East/Warsop Lane and adjacent to the bus stop outside Python Hill School have been reported to NCC.
- Severn Trent is due to carry out re-metering work in the village.
- Steps leading up to St Peters Drive require repointing, Clerk will inform NCC
