FINANCE & ACCOUNTS

It was proposed and resolved unanimously to purchase a new dog bin for the Preston Rd field.

Following complaints regarding drunken anti-social behaviour on the Preston Rd field it was noted that the area was still covered by a Designated Public Places Order. The police have been informed of the incident.

It was proposed and resolved unanimously to remove the Youth Shelter from the Preston Rd field due to recurring anti-social behaviour problems. It was unanimously agreed to offer it free of charge to local primary schools or community groups for reuse within the community.
